The American International Health Alliance (AIHA) operates under cooperative agreements with the Agency for International Development (USAID)—the US government agency that finances programs and projects that promote broad-based, sustainable economic growth worldwide. Additional funding is provided through a grant from the US Department of Energy. AIHA establishes and manages partnerships between healthcare institutions in the United States and their counterparts in Central and Eastern Europe (CEE) and the New Independent States (NIS) of the former Soviet Union. Программа партнерства АМСЗ

Американский международный союз здравоохранения (АМСЗ) действует на основании договора о сотрудничестве с Агентством по международному развитию (АМР) - правительственным учреждением США, финансирующим программы и проекты, способствующие широкому и прочному экономическому росту во всем мире. Финансовую поддержку оказывает также Министерство энергетики США. АМСЗ организует и осуществляет проведение партнерских программ между учреждениями здравоохранения в США и аналогичными организациями в Центральной и Восточной Европе (ЦВЕ), а также в Новых Независимых Государствах (ННГ) на территории бывшего Советского Союза. АМСЗ также финансирует различные формы поддержки и сотрудничества, включая проведение конференций и создание информационных служб в области здравоохранения в ННГ и странах ЦВЕ.
